

## **RULES**

- ❑ **Dressage/Combined Training Entries close Tuesday 15<sup>TH</sup> August - If classes are full a waiting list will be kept.- NO entries accepted on the day**
- ❑ **Showing classes pre-entries close Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> August but please note entries can be taken on the day**
- ❑ **Withdrawals:-** In the unfortunate event of withdrawal, please advise the Secretary by Mid-day Tuesday prior to the competition. We regret **no refunds** will be made after this time.
- ❑ **Times: Please ring 07563621050 on FRIDAY 18<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST between 7.30 & 9.00pm**
- ❑ Any special requests must be clearly put onto entry form
- ❑ Classes will be judged under BD rules and correct dress must be worn.
- ❑ Commanders allowed for all dressage tests.
- ❑ Horses may only enter once in each class competitively.

### **HEALTH & SAFETY:**

SUARC and the organising committee cannot be held responsible for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, owners, grooms, ground spectators or any other person or property whatsoever other than liability for refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of the competition.

The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and steward. All riders when riding, whether competing or not, must wear hard hats to BRC standards – see SUARC website for further details - all worn with a strap properly adjusted and fastened. Correct dress & footwear to be worn. Horses & ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years old and over. Entries accepted at rider's risk. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever. The organisers' decision is final.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
